

Parental Leave Position - Director of Family Ministries

Part-Time until April 6, 2021 (10 hrs/week during current Covid-based church closure; 25 hours/week effective upon resumption of regular activities/re-opening of church)

Central is an historic, multi-generational church in central Hamilton, committed to Reformed theology and tradition of the Presbyterian Church in Canada, in which people discover God's grace, grow as disciples of Christ, and receive resources to live and serve as mature Christians. The Director of Family Ministries (DFM) position was created to ensure that all the efforts in growing as disciples remains a vital and enlarging part of our Christian ministry with a particular focus on supporting children's and youth ministries and outreach.

Specific accountabilities include:

- Oversee the Sunday morning Nursery and Faith-finder programs, recruiting and supporting respective coordinators. and ensuring that all resources necessary are provided. The nursery is overseen by the DFM, usually with the provision of a Nursery Coordinator to schedule, organize and communicate with volunteers or with a Nursery Worker;
- Develop opportunities for children and youth to participate in worship, including but not limited to involvement in choral/ensemble groups, readings, baptisms, lectors and delegating leadership as necessary;
- Develop and administer an approved (by the Discipleship Committee) annual budget;
- Participate in education that enhances Ministry competency;
- To be a general spiritual, helping and practical resource to children and youth within the church to grow in faith and discipleship.

Qualifications:

- Experience in ministering to children, youth and families in a church setting;
- Training in theology or youth ministry is preferred;
- Ability to articulate and share a personal faith in Jesus Christ;
