PROFESSIONAL and RESEARCH INTERESTS

PROFESSIONAL AND RESEARCH INTERESTS

I utilize primarily qualitative methodologies to conduct practice-led research that engages the following intersecting aspects of counselling and spiritual care practice.

- The professional training and formation of ministry generalists and counseling specialists for the work of spiritual care and/or counseling.
- The formation and maintenance of the therapeutic alliance with individuals, couples, and families.
- Counselling those who perpetrate or have experienced abuse within families and intimate relationships.

I utilize historical and contemporary models of theological reflection and theological integration to explore the interface of faith, spirituality and theology with the practice of spiritual care and counselling and to reflect theologically on subject of marriage and family.

RESEARCH

Current Practice-led quantitative study of the role of case notes in the professional

formation of counsellors. Status: in progress.

Current Practice-informed study of graduate student's experiences of clinical

supervision. Phase One of this study yielded 22 usable responses to a

quantitative survey (12 social work students, 5 counselling students and 5 spiritual care students). All groups pointed to the important role of the supervisor in their professional formation. The data suggests there may be important differences between the types of learning experiences of social work students and those who are studying to be counsellor-therapists or spiritual care providers. However, further study is required to support this suggestion. Next steps include revising the methodology with a view of obtaining a clearer understanding of any differences and similarities between intern experiences.

2016 A re-examination of the use of κεφαλή and ὑποτάσσω in Eph 5:21–33.

God and Family: A Social-Theological Framework for Ministering to Families.

Qualitative study (Delphi methodology) of strategies used by agencies to provide child witnesses of domestic violence with access to counselling services (11 participants). Surveyed agencies in Ontario and British Columbia with respect to their experiences providing services to children who have witnessed domestic violence and the procedures they use when one parent attempts to interfere with their ability provide service to a child. Major findings suggest that service providers consider their first responsibility to ensure the safety of the child(ren) and the non-offending parent. The findings of this study also suggest that service providers maintain their commitment to best practice while seeking to relate to the offending parent in ways that communicate empathy and respect. (results provided to sponsoring agency)

Review of the literature relating to African marriage practices prepared for the pastor and church board of a local church. Literature identified five tyes of marriage not familiar to North Americans; i.e., bride price, bush marriage, progressive marriage, levirate marriage, and polygamy. Discussion identified a variety of ways a church can choose to respond to these "irregular" marriages. (results provided to pastor and board of the church)

Practice-led quality of the role of case notes in the professional formation of counsellors (preliminary study). **Phase One** of this study involved an autoethnographic reflection on my experiences as a supervisor and writing clinical notes. This process resulted in the creation of a format for writing notes. **Phase Two** of this study employed the format developed in the first phase to teach note writing to interns (n=28 trainees), supported student counsellors as they learned to write notes, and elicited feedback with respect to their experience using this format after the completion of the intern's placement (n=13 respondents). The major finding of this preliminary study suggests that the experience of writing clinical case notes contributes to their professional formation. (results provided to sponsoring agency)

Practice-led research (narrative / autoethnographic methodology) that reflected on my clinical experience interviewing couples. This research focused specifically on the first interview, noting the challenge of creating a safe place for each partner while seeking to obtain a description of the challenges faced by the couple. This study resulted in the creation of a procedure for the first interview with couples. (results unpublished)

2008 to 2010 Practice-led quantitative study (n=71) that explored student perceptions of how classroom pedagogies contribute to their professional formation as pastors and pastoral counsellors. Major findings suggest that integrative pedagogical methods result in constructive formational outcomes, and that students benefit from intensive instruction in a specific framework for pastoral counseling. (results published)

Quantitative study (n=301) of Christians' perceptions of and responses to five approaches to pastoral marital counseling. Major findings: a) self-identified evangelicals differentiate between counselling models both in terms of the degree to which they fit with Evangelical values as well as their potential to help; b) Emotionally Focused Couples Therapy (EFCT) was consistently rated highly by the participants; and, none of the models studied was rated in a way that would suggest that participants rated it is a better model for working with evangelical couples experiencing marital distress. (results published)

Divergent Visions: Institutional vs. Aspirational Visions of the Family (quantitative study, n=176). Study utilized the Family Adaptability and Cohesion Scale (FACES III) to explore for differences between the participants' opinions of religious views on the family and their personal views. Major findings suggest there may be a significant discrepancy between Christians' personal aspirations for family life and their perceptions of an ideal Christian family and that these differences appear to be most pronounced among college age young adults and individuals in mid-life. (results unpublished)

Mixed-methods study (quantitative and qualitative) of abusive men (n=45) using the Taylor-Johnson Temperament Analysis (T-JTA). Major findings included a) that the TJTA helps abusive men to disclose things about themselves which they might not disclose in an interview; b) TJTA profiles of abusive men reveal psychosocial characteristics that may help them to address their attitudes towards others and the need to develop impulse control; and, c) TJTA profiles of abusive men suggest that they come to therapy with multiple therapeutic needs. (results published in MTh Thesis)

Qualitative study (Ethnographic) that explored for the presence of an indigenous understanding of human development among Salvadoran refugees (9 participants). Major finding: an analysis of the participants understanding of Spanish-language vocabulary suggests a culturally and linguistically embedded awareness of a four stage life-cycle model. (results unpublished)

Qualitative study (Phenomenological) that identified and explored the losses experienced by Salvadoran refugees (6 participants). Major finding confirmed that the refugee experience has aspects that are emotionally similar to the grief experience. (results unpublished)

Qualitative study (Phenomenological) of the challenges experienced by Central American refugees in Canada (6 participants). Explored the issues faced by refugees. Major findings included confirmation that social workers,

counsellors and clergy need to become familiar with the multiple stressors experienced by refugees, both when they flee their homeland as well as in settlement. (results unpublished)

Practice-based mixed methods study (survey plus randomly selected interviews) of pastoral beliefs, values and practices with respect to officiating at the marriage of a professing Christian and a non-Christian (52 participants). Major findings: a) participants reported only 14.3% of non-Christians spouses had converted at some point after the wedding; b) major issues faced by mixed faith couples include value conflicts, relationship issues, and spiritual/faith issues; c) 22 out of 52 respondents (42%) indicated that despite their theological position they had agreed to perform a wedding between a professing Christian and a non-Christian. (results unpublished)

Practice-led research study (mixed methods) using church archives and personal interviews that explored the correlation between church marriage practices with respect to mixed-faith marriage and subsequent church attendance. Major finding: as a general rule church attendance and faith practice by both the Christian and non-Christian partner tends to decrease significantly or cease after the wedding. (results unpublished)

Qualitative study (ethnographic) that focused on the effect of one spouse's conversion to Christianity on the religious attitudes of the other spouse (10 participants). Major findings: a) the introduction of a new value system into a family is likely to challenge established values, upsets family equilibrium; b) families in which one spouse has either expressed an interest in religion, or converted to a new faith, appear to go through three identifiable stages (i.e., an initial phase of exploration, a transition phase, and a resolution phase). (results unpublished)
