Discovery vs. Catalogue

The MMULS offers two distinct search systems: **Discovery** and **Catalogue**.



What are they? How are they different from each other?



Discovery finds materials for you not only from our own holdings but also from external databases (full-text and index-only), i.e. it takes you beyond McMaster University.




Catalogue search is only limited to our own holdings (books, e-books, specific journal subscriptions, print periodicals), i.e. it is an internal search limited to McMaster University libraries.

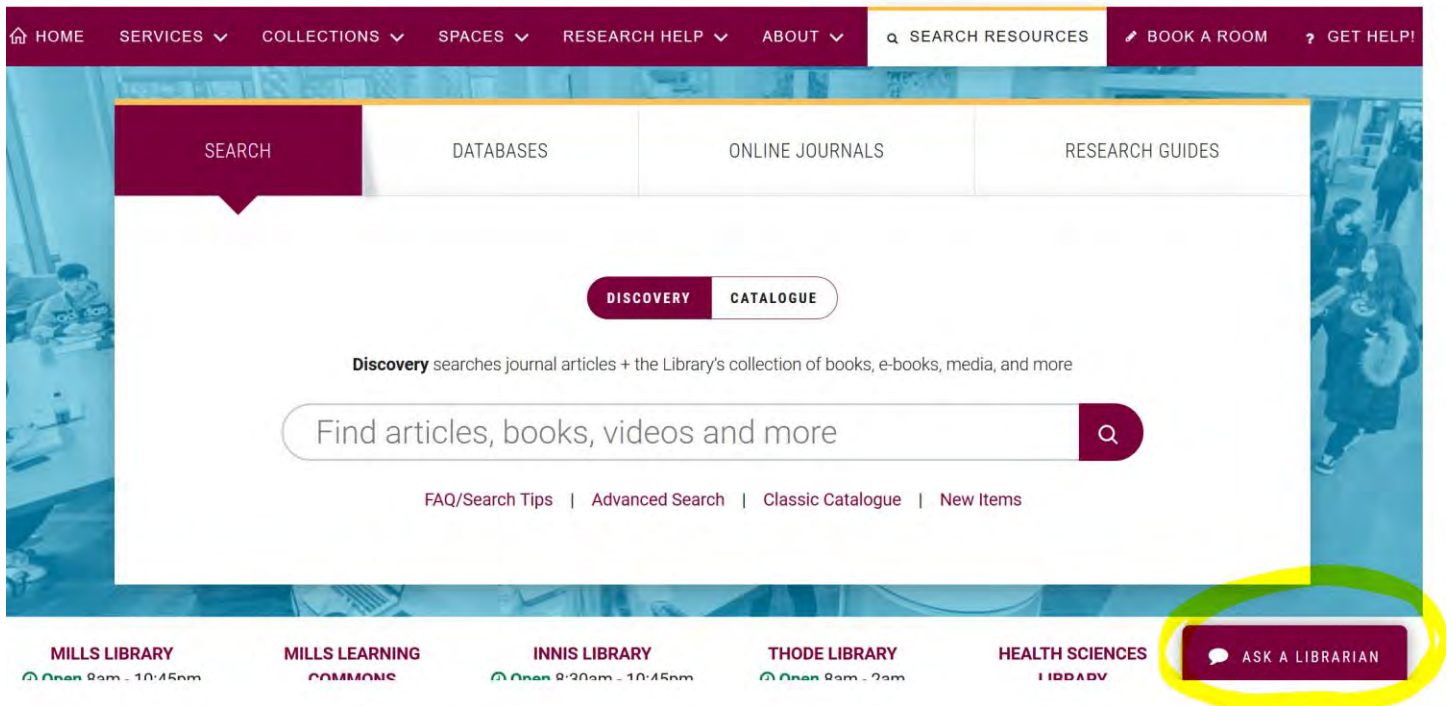

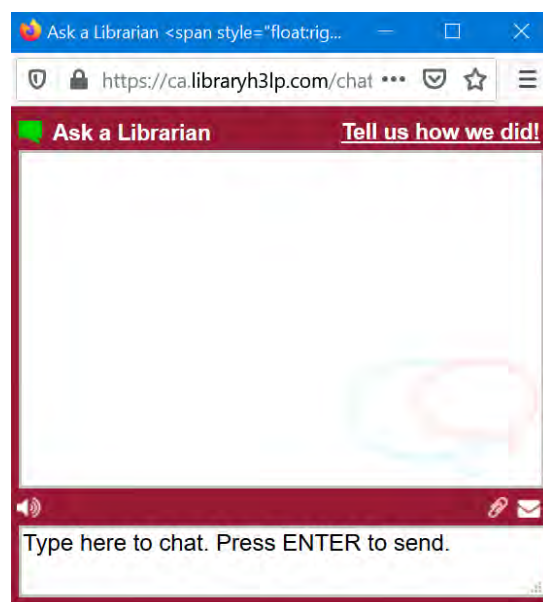
Live Chat: Ask A Librarian

One of the best features of the MMULS is that the librarians are very accessible and responsive. Let's try to use its live chat assistance system called **Ask A Librarian**.

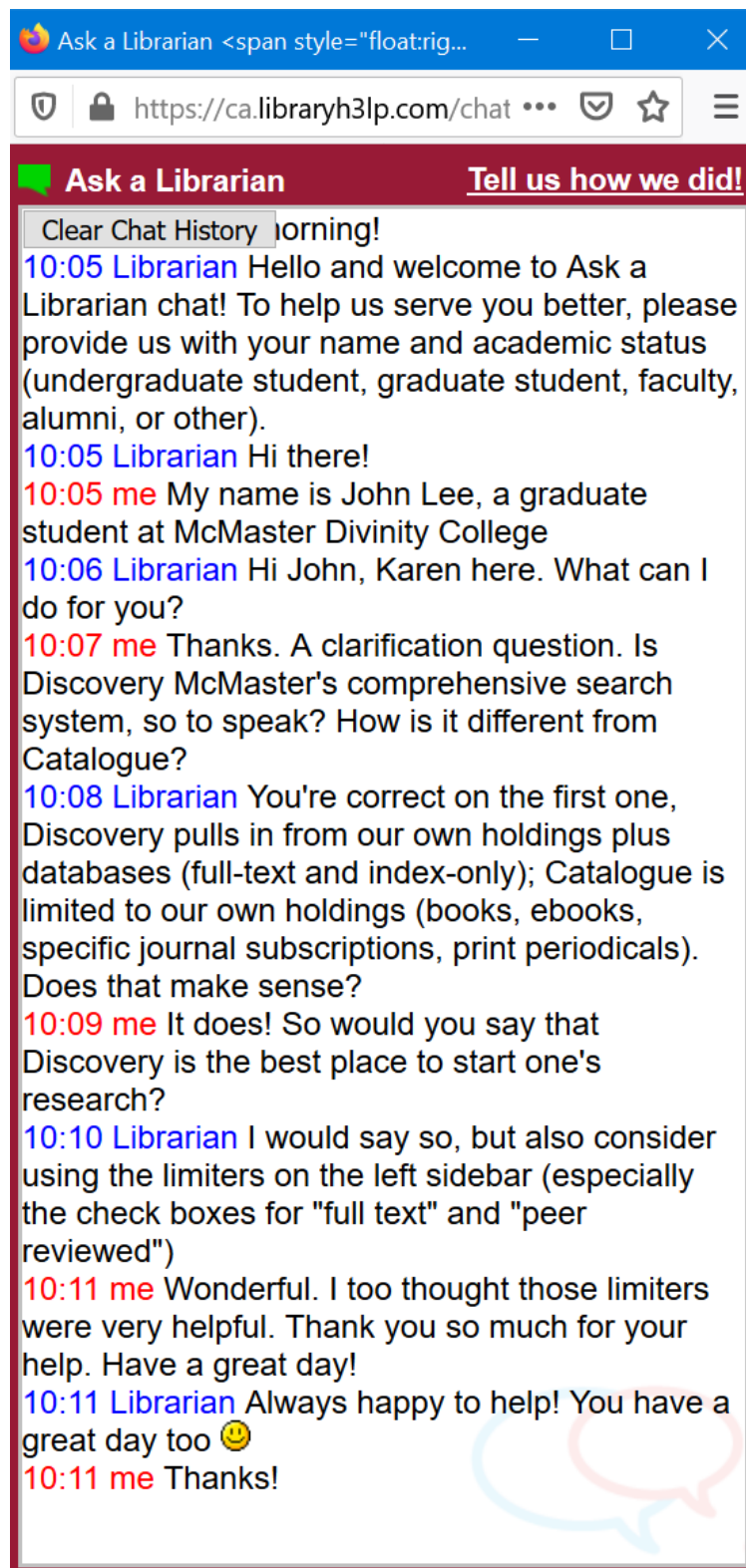
Once you are in the MMULS website, you will always see  in the lower right corner of the screen.

Will they really respond? Trust me. They will. Let's ask them about **Discovery** and **Catalogue**.



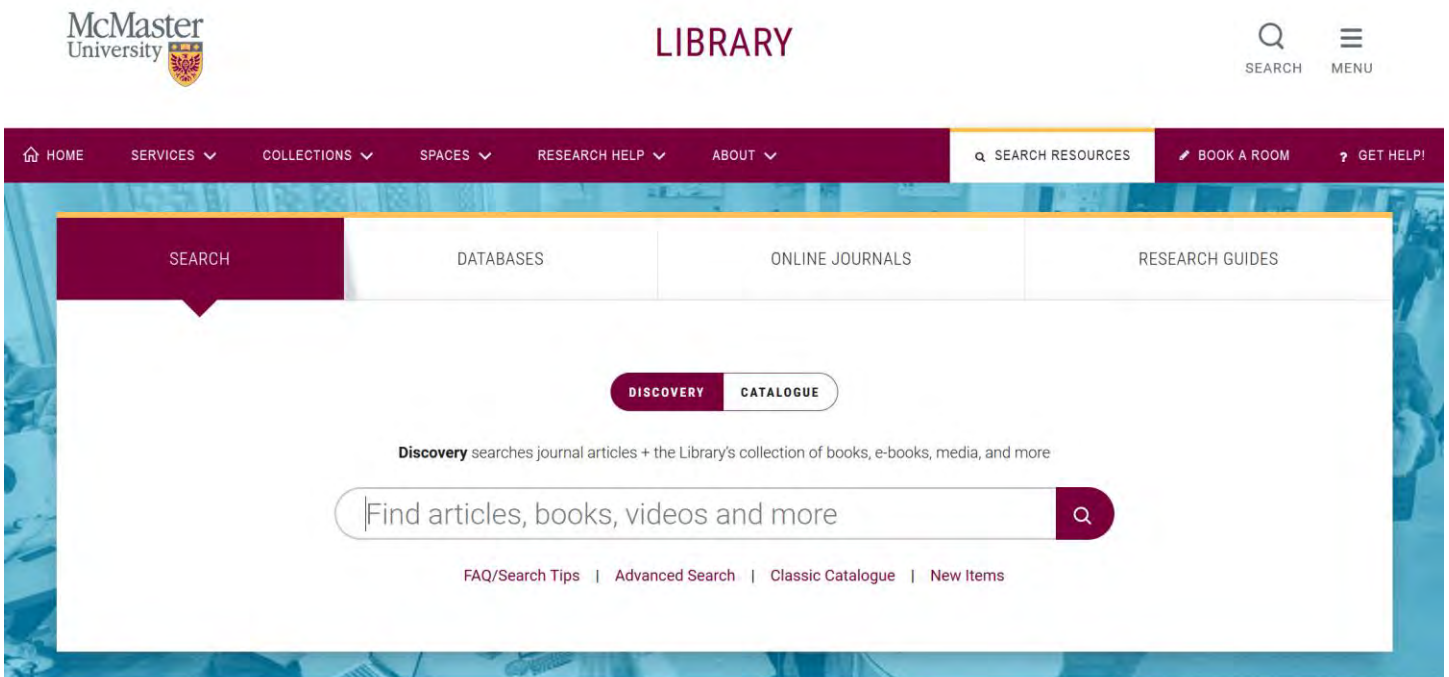



Option 1: Discovery or Catalogue

- (1) Let's try to find the following article as a test case: Haenchen, E. "Schriftzitate und Textüberlieferung in der Apostelgeschichte." *ZThK* 51 (1954) 153–67.
- (2) Go to the McMaster University Libraries System (MMULS): <https://library.mcmaster.ca/>



- (3) You have two options: 
- (4) It is better to choose  if you are looking for a journal article. **Discovery** is very powerful. It will help you find most of the articles that you look for.
- (5) Type the author's name and the title into the search pane. Note that you do not always need to enter the author's full name and the paper's full title. Click the magnifying glass icon.



- (6) The result page looks like the following. As you can see, it was an easy search. Click the  button to view the article. You can also click  to view it from the JSTOR database. The result, however, is the same. (**Remember, you will probably be prompted to log in** however, that if you are accessing off-campus,

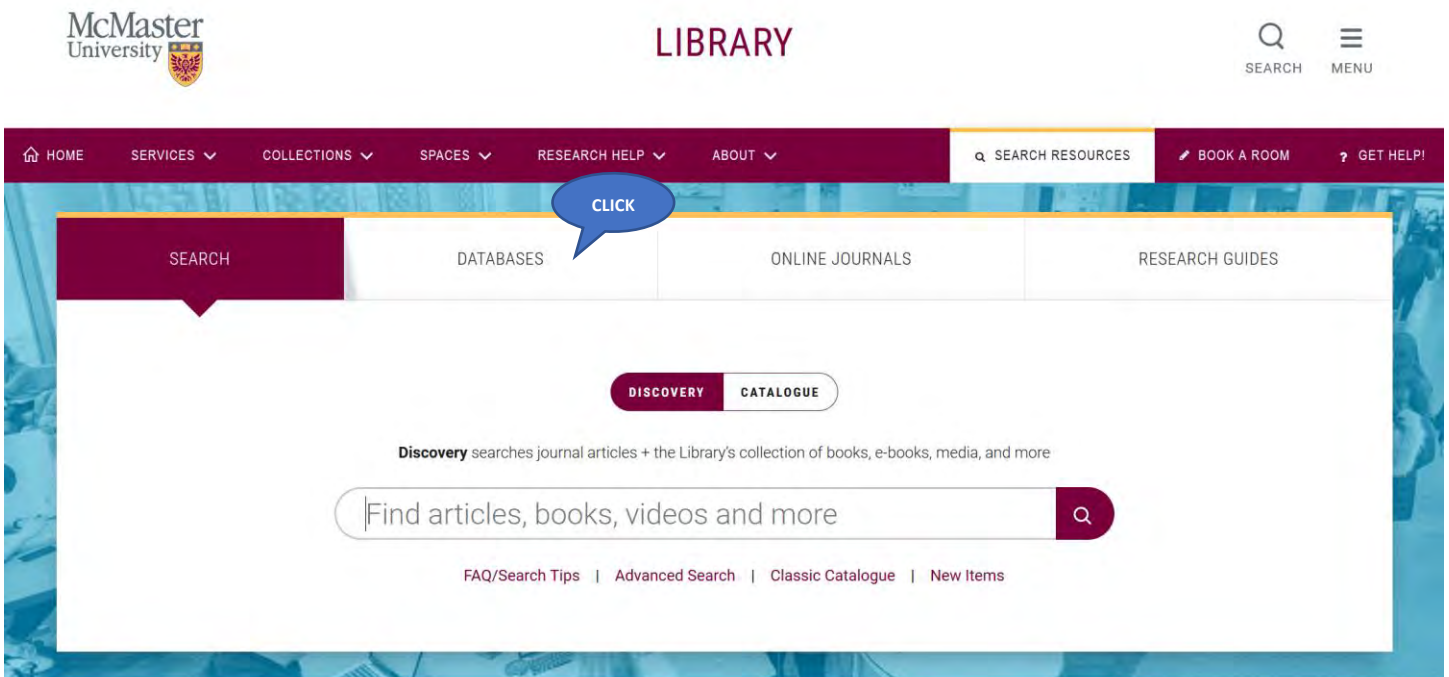

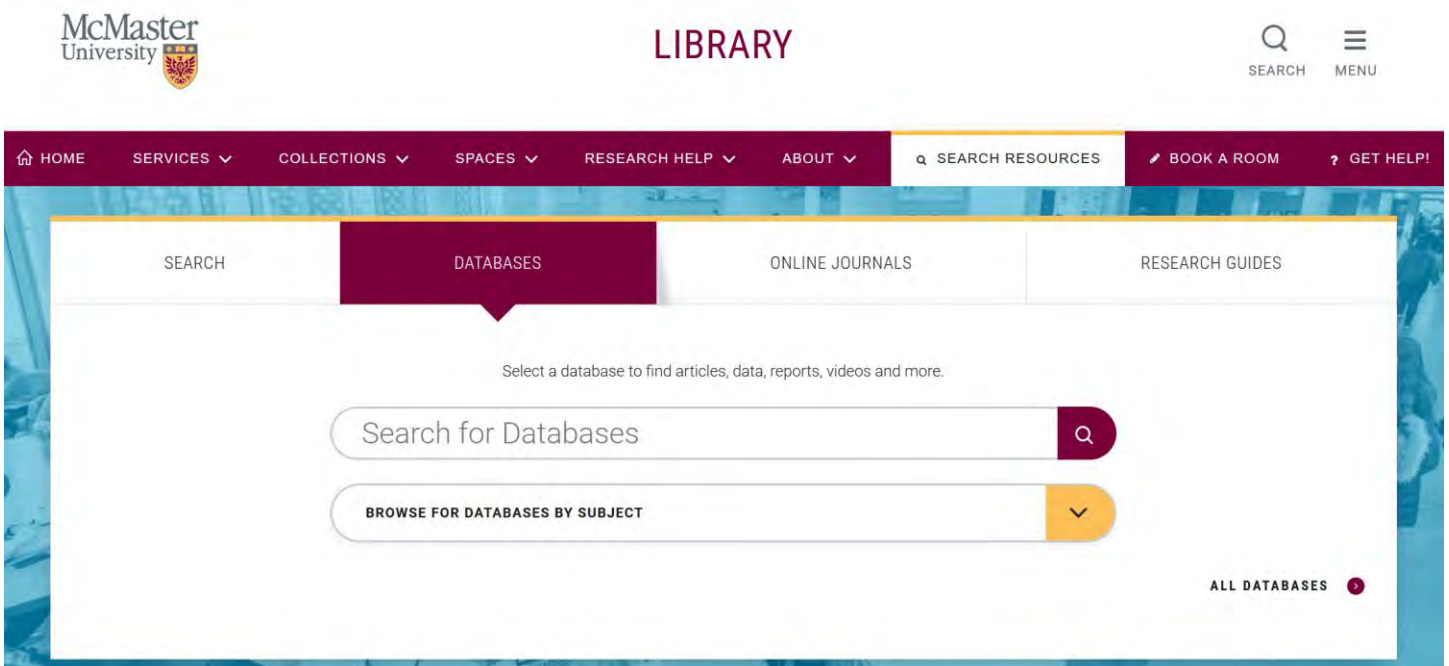
Although **Discovery** and **Catalogue** constitute a powerful search system, there are occasions that you want to access various databases and online journal sites yourself in order to carry out a more detailed, refined search. The following four options (Option 2, 3, 4, and 5) will help you do it.

Option 2: ATLA Database

- (1) Let's find the following article: Porter, Stanley E. "The Argument of Romans 5: Can a Rhetorical Question Make a Difference?" *Journal of Biblical Literature* 110 (1991) 655–77.
- (2) Again, direct your browser to the MMULS: <https://library.mcmaster.ca/>
- (3) Click the **DATABASES** tab because we want to directly access scholarly databases this time.



- (4) Then, you will see the following:



- (5) MDC faculty members' and students' most frequently used database would be **ATLA** (American Theological Libraries Association) Religious Studies Database. So, type **ATLA** in the search pane.

ATLA Religious Studies Database with ATLASerials

Coverage: 1949 to present, though indexing for some journal titles extends back to 1818
Covers religion and theology. Contains 1.4 million citations to articles from 1,500+ journals, essays and book reviews, and a growing number of multimedia citations. There are links to full text for 140,000+ articles and book reviews from 70+ major religion and theology journals selected by leading religion scholars in the United States. The database begins in 1949 although indexing for some journal titles extends back to 1818. Produced by the American Theological Library Association, the ATLA Religious Studies Database (formerly known as the Religious Studies Index) covers such topics as Biblical studies, world religions, church history, and religious perspectives on social issues.

17th and 18th Century Burney Collection Newspapers

The largest single collection of 17th and 18th century English news media available from the British Library, this primary sources database includes more than 1,000 pamphlets, proclamations, newsbooks and newspapers from the period. The collection charts the development of the newspaper as we now know it, beginning with irregularly published transcriptions of Parliamentary debates and proclamations to coffee house newsbooks, finally arriving at newspaper in its current form.

17th and 18th Century Nichols Newspapers Collection New

Coverage: 1672-1737

Features the newspapers, periodicals, pamphlets and broadsheets that form the Nichols newspaper collection held at the Bodleian Libraries in Oxford, United Kingdom. All 296 volumes of bound material, covering the period 1672-1737 have been digitized. This collection charts the history of the development of the press in England and provides invaluable insight into 17th and 18th century England.

This primary sources collection also includes approximately 300 pamphlets and broadsheets, most prevalent in the 1672-1682 period.

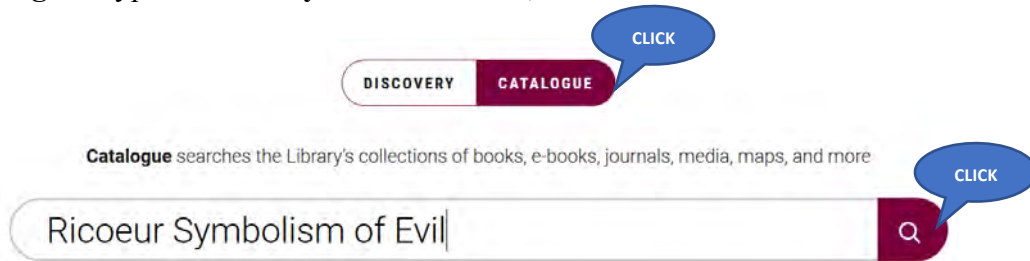
