However, the time may take longer depending upon circumstances. Defences are at least 2 hours in length and are normally scheduled at 10:00 am or 2:00 pm on Wednesday to Friday when school is in session and any day of the week when classes are finished. Date and time will be determined by the Registrar, based on faculty availability.
